



What is JRS?


Judicial Retirement System (JRS) is a pension plan that provides a lifetime benefit at retirement.

Eligibility: Certain State of Georgia Judicial Employees

If you have previous ERS service, you must request your transfer options to the JRS plan within 90 days of your new membership.

Normal Retirement

- **Age 60** with at least **16 years of service**
- Your lifetime benefit is **66.66% of your salary, plus 1% for each year between 16 and 24 years of service**



Early Retirement

- **Age 60** with at least **10 years of service**
- Calculated with a reduction for each year of service under 16

Contribution Rates



The employee contribution rate for JRS is **7.5% of earnable compensation**. For some employees, the employer pays a portion of these contributions.

Beneficiaries

Options are available to leave continuing benefits for a beneficiary depending on hire date.
