

Fund Objective

The Fund seeks to track the performance of MSCI All Country World ex USA Index.

Fund Composition

The Fund invests in stocks that make up the MSCI All Country World ex USA Index. The Index is comprised of foreign stocks representing companies in 22 developed markets and 23 emerging markets. The Index represents approximately 60% of the world's total market capitalization.

Investor Profile

This fund is intended for long-term investors seeking to capture the earnings and growth potential of foreign companies in both developed and emerging countries throughout the world. Investing in foreign markets may offer additional diversification benefits to an investment portfolio. Diversification increases the chances that one investment's strong performance will offset another investment's poor performance.

Fund Risks

The performance of the Fund depends on the value of its holdings. Stock values may vary from day to day in response to individual companies and general market and economic conditions.
