

# What is JRS?


Judicial Retirement System (JRS) is a pension plan that provides a lifetime benefit at retirement.

Eligibility: Certain State of Georgia Judicial Employees

If you have previous ERS service, you must request your transfer options to the JRS plan within 90 days of your new membership.

#### Normal Retirement

- Age 60 with at least
  16 years of service
- Your lifetime benefit is 66.66% of your salary, plus 1% for each year between 16 and 24 years of service



# Early Retirement

- Age 60 with at least 10 years of service
- Calculated with a reduction for each year of service under 16



## Contribution Rates

The employee contribution rate for JRS is **7.5% of earnable compensation**. For some employees, the employer pays a portion of these contributions.

## Beneficiaries

Options are available to leave continuing benefits for a beneficiary depending on hire date.
