## 2023 Legislative Session Convenes

The House and Senate officially convened on Monday, January 9th for the first day of the 2023 Legislative Session. The day was filled with official activities, such as the swearing-in of several new House and Senate members.

The House elected Representative Jon Burns (R-Newington) as the new Speaker of the House and also elected Representative Jan Jones (R-Milton) as Speaker Pro Tempore. Lieutenant Governor Burt Jones will preside over the Senate. Senator John Kennedy (R-Macon) was elected to serve as President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

Governor Brian P. Kemp was sworn-in as Georgia's 83rd Governor on January 12th at the Georgia State Convocation Center. Also sworn-in was Leiutentant Governor Burt Jones, along with other Constitutional Officers of the State. The Georgia Strong Committee made the ceremony a wonderful and memorable event that ERSGA staff was honored to attend.

### **New House and Senate Committees**

The 2023 Legislative Session brings several changes to the membership of Legislative Committees in the General Assembly. Senator Rick Williams (R-Milledgeville) is the newly appointed Senate Retirement Committee Chair. The House Committee on Assignments has not released the Chair or members of the House Retirement Committee at this time.
